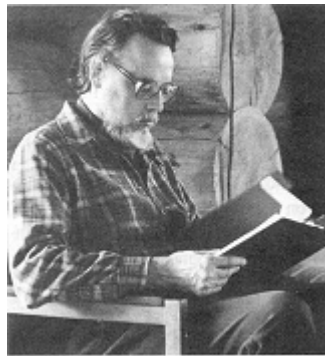

ESSAYS ON BIBLICAL INTERPRETATION: ANABAPTIST-MENNONITE PERSPECTIVES (Text-Reader Series #1)

Willard Swartley, editor.

1984. Institute for Mennonite Studies. Paperback. 334 pages.

Includes TWO Yoder essays:

- **“The Hermeneutics of the Anabaptists”** p. 11-28.
- **“The Authority of the Canon”** p. 265-290.

This is one of the best books on biblical interpretation in the Anabaptist tradition. I refer to my own copy often. It is also very hard-to-find. There's only been one copy of it available on Amazon this year and it sold for between \$75 and \$80. Because this one is not in the best shape, I'm selling it for less than half that price.

Mentions Yoder's participation as a discussion group leader

"J. H. Yoder, Wooster, Ohio, now Valdoie, France" (p. 10).

And as a North American delegate of the Mennonite Church (p. 24).

An early historical record of Yoder's representing the Mennonite Church in an official role. He was 25 at the time.

\$8 - Good. Binding solid, clean pages. Moderate to heavy wear, esp. to front cover (some tearing on bottom edge, some curling of top corners).
